Supplementary Regulations

Announcement: The Sidcup and District Motor Cycle Club Ltd will hold an Open Hare and Hounds event. Held under the ACU National Sporting Code, the Hare and Hounds Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions that may be issued.

Insurance: The insurance cover for this event will be Basic (limit of liability £10M) and Medical Malpractice insurance (limit of liability £5M) is included. There is NO Personal Accident Insurance for Competitors. Competitors are therefore strongly recommended to purchase such Cover which is available through the Lockton's website (www.locktonmotorsport.com) or the ACU website (www.acu.org.uk).

Entries: Open 06:00 on 13th August 2018 Close 06:00 on 10th September 2018, or earlier when the limit of 200 riders is reached.

Fee: £48.00. If you do not have a 2018 ACU Enduro or Motocross Licence, the on-line system will add £15 to the entry fee for a One Day Licence.

Maximum number of entries accepted – 200 Adult riders.

Any Late Entries accepted after the closing date may be subject to a £10 surcharge. Late entries will be riding on a 'no award' basis. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT**.

At the event, all entrants must show their ACU licence card when signing on. Those on a 'day' licence must show some form of ID with a 'true-likeness' photograph on it.

Having entered the event if you become a non-starter you must explain your absence to the promoting club. Failure to do so is a breach of the rules.

Course: Length: 5 to 6 miles per lap; Event time 3 hours. A lap will include the Motocross track (but not as a complete lap), surrounding woodland and fields.

Classes: ADULT: Minimum age - 15 on (on 16 September 2018) on 250cc (max)

A: Championship E: Clubman A I: Clubman B
B: Expert F: Veteran B (riders 40 years or over) J: Sportsman

C: Veteran A (riders over 40) G: Veteran B (riders 50 years or over)

D: Veteran A (riders over 50) H: Evo (machines pre-1990)

Awards: Premier in each class, then 'Gold' for next 10% of starters; 'Silver' for next 10%; 'Bronze' for next 10%. Gold, Silver and Bronze subject to a minimum of 6 starters in that class.

Medication: It is your responsibility to declare at signing on if you are taking any drugs, you may be tested. Child Protection: The Secretary of the Meeting is the point of contact (National Sporting Code 6.21)

Tyres: Enduro, Trials or Motocross tyres may be used. Enduro and Motocross bikes may be used.

Number Plates: Any colours for numbers and backgrounds, but they must be contrasting colours.

General: Signing-On and Technical Control will be from 08.30.to 10:00. Riders' briefing at 10:10. Results will be on the Sidcup Club website, www.sidcupmotorcycleclub.co.uk within 24 hours. Strict speed restrictions in Blue Tape areas will be applied. Transgression will be instant disqualification.

All riders note: Any accepted riders who are "no-shows" on the day of the event will not receive any entry fee back and they will NOT be accepted for future Canada Heights Enduros or Hare and Hounds.

ENTRY FORM

DECLARATION: I the undersigned apply to enter the event described herein and in consideration thereof:

- 3. I confirm that I understand the nature and type of events and the risk inherent with the sport and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risk may involve negligence on the part of the organisers/officials.
- 4. I further agree that I will not seek to claim against the ACU, the organisers nor their officials, the landowners, the promoter or other bodies or individuals connected with the event in respect to any damage to my property howsoever caused, and whether by the negligence or breach of statutory duty of the said bodies or persons.
- 5. I further agree that the machine that I enter and compete on shall be suitable and proper for the purpose and that it will comply with the regulations respect thereof, and is described below.
- 6. I understand and agree that I am required to register my arrival by signing on at the event office not less than 30 minutes prior to commencement of the event
