## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1. JURISDICTION: Held under the National Sporting Code, Environmental Code and Standing TRIALS regulations of the ACU, Trials Regulations of ACU South Eastern, these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions that may be issued.
- ELIGIBILITY: The Competition is open to adult members of ACU clubs and riders from EU countries, riding solo or sidecar machines of BRITISH or EUROPEAN MANUFACTURE (British only for class F) made before 31 December 1966.
- 3. ENTRIES: Entries on-line using ACU/Sport80, or 'paper' entry form on the Sidcup Club website. All entrants must show proof of 2024 ACU Trials Registration at Canada Heights unless they bought a One-Event Trials Licence for £5.00 when entering on-line. Entries open on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> October and close 27<sup>th</sup> November, or before, if full. Limited to 120 entries. NO new entries will be accepted on the day of the trial.

If a non-starter, it is required that you explain your absence to the promoting club. Failure to do so is a breach of the Rules – and will probably deprive a Reserve a ride!

Results will be on the Sidcup Club website 24 hours or less after the trial.

- 4. FEES: Solo £22.00. Sidecar £27:00
- COURSE: Canada Heights Motorcycle Sport Circuit, Button Street, Swanley, Kent, BR8 8DX. (All on private land). Triple sections with different coloured cards. White hard route, Red easier route, Yellow easiest route. The entry form shows which routes are available for each class.
- 6. CLASSES:
  - A. Pre-unit fourstrokes of single or twin cylinder construction (sprung frames).
  - B. Unit construction fourstrokes (sprung frames).
  - C. Rigid framed machines with single or twin fourstroke engines and having girder front forks.
  - D. Rigid framed machines with single or twin fourstroke engines and having telescopic front forks.
  - E. Any British two-stroke with sprung or unsprung frames.
  - F. Any British two-stroke with rigid frame, telescopic or girder forks.
  - G. 'Gentlemen/Ladies' riding bikes of any of the above classes A to F, but on the yellow (easiest) route.
  - H. Any British or European bike with Sidecar, sprung or unsprung.
- AWARDS: Jack Thompson British Bike Trophy to Best Performance of Class A riding the White route. Vinall Trophy to the Best performance in Classes C or D riding the red route. The Burlingham Challenge Cup of Class H (Sidecar).
- 8. MEDICATION: It is your responsibility to declare before the day if you are taking any drugs, you may be tested.
- **9.** LATE START: One mark will be added for every minute late, after 30 minutes rider will be deemed to be a non-starter.
- **10. MARKING:** TSR 22 B (Non-stop), 0 1 2 3 5 & <u>10 for missing a section</u>, no bunny hopping, rolling backwards or balancing stationary will apply.
- 11. CAMPING at Canada Heights Saturday to Sunday is free no need to book.

I accept responsibility for any items borrowed from the Organiser during the the event. These items include but are not restricted to (safety clothing, accessories). I understand that I am liable for the cost or replacement of any items lost or not returned and non-payment or non-replacement of items borrowed may affect my entry into subsequent events.

I confirm that I have not been refused an ACU Licence, nor had an ACU Licence suspended, nor have I been excluded from any ACU competition.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE RISKS OF MOTORSPORT: I understand that by taking part in this event I am exposed to a risk of death, becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury. I acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of the ACU, any event organiser, any circuit owner, the promoter, the organising club, the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on their behalf were to be a contributory cause of any serious injury.
