SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- **1 ANNOUNCEMENT**: The Sidcup & DMCC Ltd. will organise a round of the British Sidecar Cross Championship and the National Expert Sidecar Cross Championship on Sunday 1st June 2025 at Canada Heights Motosport Circuit. It is open to eligible competitors as in the 2025 ACU British Sidecar Cross Championship Conditions, and solo Adult ACU Club members.
- **2 JURISDICTION:** The meeting will be held under the current National Sporting Code of the ACU, the Standing Regulations for Motocross, the 2025 ACU British Sidecar Cross Championship conditions and any further Supplementary Regulations or Instructions issued, or official announcements made.
- **3. INSURANCE:** The insurance cover for this event will be Basic (limit of liability £10M) is included. There is NO Personal Accident Insurance for Competitors.
- **3 COURSE:** The course is situated at Canada Heights Motosport Circuit, Button Street, Swanley, Kent. BR8 8DX. Signposted from the M20/M25 roundabout Junction 3 of the M25.

The track is approximately 1.8kms of sandy hillside terrain with man made jumps. Start method by drop down start gate.

4 ELIGIBILITY:

<u>Sidecar</u>: Open to riders and Passengers holding current Motocross licences issued by the ACU and SACU or holding a current National licence issued by their European FMN. Any competitor not holding an ACU or SACU licence must provide proof of Insurance and a written start permission document issued by their FMN.

Solo: Open to members of all ACU clubs and holding a 2025 ACU or SACU Motocross licence. Day licences are available.

5. ENTRIES: All entries will be made via the online platform. Solo Entry opens on 17th April and close 30th May or when full. Sidecars open on 17th April and close on 17th May or when full.

<u>Sidecar</u>: Riders/Passengers who registered with the ACU £85.00.

Riders/Passengers who are not registered - £100.00.

Entries received after the closing date (15 days before the event) will incur an additional charge of £20.00.

Solo: Experts and Juniors - **£61.00**.

6. PASSES / VENUE ADMISSION: Each registered Sidecar Team will be allowed entry for 4 people including the Rider and Passenger. Each Solo rider will be allowed entry for 2 people including the Rider. Anyone else arriving with the Team/Rider will be required to pay the normal admission fee at the entrance gate.

7. GENERAL:

- Tear-offs are not permitted.
- No pit bikes, no electric motorcycles, scooters, Revvis, Osets, etc.
- Use of Electric-assisted cycles by authorised users only.
- FIRE EXTINGUISHERS WILL BE CHECKED AT TECHNICAL & RANDOMLY IN PADDOCK (1 per vehicle)
- Please take any rubbish home with you. Take used tyres away with you as it is an offence not to dispose of them in the correct manner.
- Overnight Camping in designated area only from 12.30 pm Saturday, Gates Close 9 pm. If you cannot arrive by then, please arrive on Sunday.
- Silence in the paddock will commence at 9.30pm
