SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS: final instructions may also be issued.

1. <u>JURISDICTION</u>: Held under the ACU National Sporting Code, the ACU Environmental Code, the ACU Hare and Hounds Regulations of the ACU.

BASIC INSURANCE: The insurance cover for this event will be Basic (limit of liability £10M) and Medical Malpractice insurance (limit of liability £5m) is included. There is NO Personal Accident Insurance for Competitors. Competitors are therefore strongly recommended to purchase such Cover.

2. **ELIGIBILITY**: Open to members of the Sidcup & District Motor Cycle Club initially, then open to all.

NOTE: This event is NOT the South Eastern Enduro Combine Championship H&H.

That event opened on 17th March, also on goracemx.com. It may well be full by now!

- 3. **ENTRIES**: Solo entries via www.goracemx.com entry system Fee: £50 for Sidcup Members only until 9th April, thereafter £60 for riders from all clubs including Sidcup. Riders who do NOT have a 2025 ACU Licence for Enduro or Motocross should leave the Licence box blank. GoraceMX will add £5 to the entry fee for a 1-event licence so you have nothing to pay on the day. Opens on Monday 31st March 2025, at 8pm, closes 18th April or when full. Any online entry that is returned is subject to a £5 handling fee.
- 4. **CLASSES**: Open to all solo Enduro and Motocross riders and bikes.
- 5. COURSE: Approx. 6km of the motocross track (in several bits), woods, grass fields.
 Note especially for Motocross riders: the track will of a technical 'enduro' nature; not just a blast round the MX track and grass field. However, it will be rideable by MX riders and bikes and give you a good four-hour workout!
- 6. **EVENT FORMAT**: First riders away at 10:00 the session ends at 14:00. No lap or time checks; riders may stop in the refuelling area whenever they like for as long as they like!
- 7. **MEDICATION**: It is your responsibility to declare at signing on if you are taking any drugs. You may be asked to take part in a drugs test.

GENERAL:

- The meeting will be cancelled if insufficient entries are received a week prior to closing date.
- No riding of machines in the paddock.
- Lights are not required to be fitted and any tyres may be used.
- Tear-offs on goggles are NOT permitted at this event (or at any event at Canada Heights).
- There will be a Food Van on site.
- Walking pace in blue tape areas. This includes the refuelling area.
- Fire extinguishers will be checked randomly in the Paddock (1 per vehicle).
